Rules for all Painting Challenges

Entries will not be accepted unless they meet the following Challenge rules exactly - NO

EXCEPTIONS

- 1. Do not sign your painting.
- 2. Entries must fit the theme.
- 3. Unless your entry will be a sealed painting, entries must be matted (they do not need to be framed).
- 4. Entries may only be submitted into one Challenge. You may not enter a challenge painting into a second Challenge, even if it fits the theme.
- 5. Entries must be new, having been painted specifically for the Challenge.
- 6. Entries cannot have been shown in an exhibit prior to the Challenge.


